**DIRECTIONS TO THE BENICIA HISTORICAL MUSEUM**

from Google Maps

From I780 take EAST 5TH or EAST 2ND ST and go SOUTH (toward downtown). TURN LEFT on MILITARY EAST and continue to the STOP sign. Take ADAMS ST to the left and continue to PARK RD. Turn LEFT at PARK RD, proceed up the hill and cross under the freeway. The MUSEUM is on the RIGHT - just up the road.
